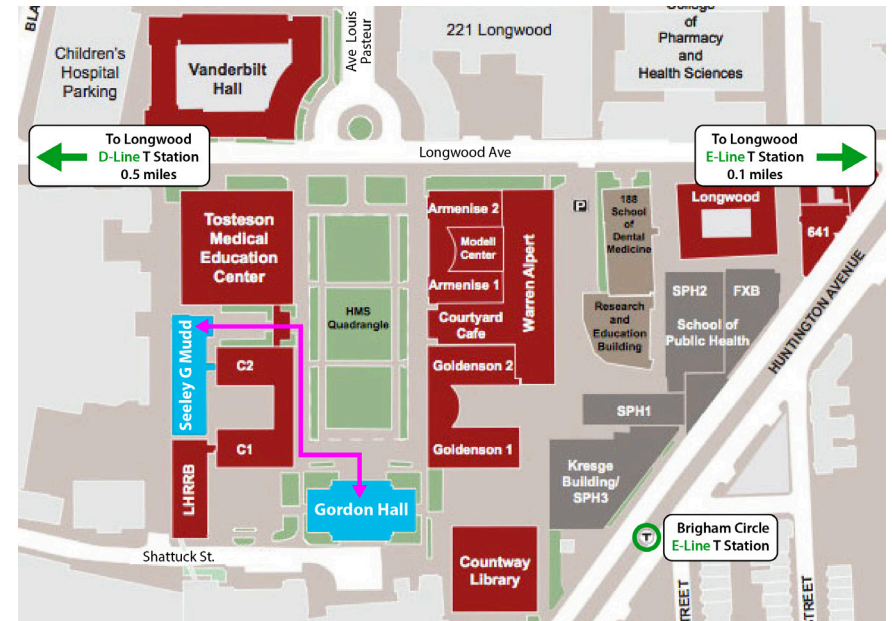

Transit options to Boston Logan Airport

Uber and **Lyft** ride services are both available in Boston to drop-off at Logan airport. Typical car arrival times are ~5min. Trip time from HMS is between 20 and 45min depending on traffic. Base ride cost is \$15-\$20, but can be more depending on time of day. Good pickup locations are 178 Avenue Louis Pasteur, Boston, MA 02115 just north of the HMS Quad across Longwood Ave, or 25 Shattuck St, Boston, MA 02115 immediately south of Gordon Hall.

Multiple **Taxi** companies service the airport. Taxis can often be found immediately to the west of the HMS Quad in the Children's Hospital roundabout at Blackfan Cir. Trip time from HMS is between 20 and 45min depending on traffic. Boston taxis have a bit of a reputation and typical costs are ~\$35-\$55.

The **MBTA "T"** train/subway transit system runs to Logan airport. From HMS, take any "Green" line inbound to Government Center. There, transfer to the outbound "Blue" line. Debark at Airport station and board a shuttle to your terminal. Total ride time with transfers ~45min, but should allow at least 1hr. Trains can be crowded at rush hour. Cost is a flat fare of \$2.65.
